CASAL DI SERRA 2017

Lovely, ripe-pear character with a hint of baking spice, making this generous and quite richly textured white enticing. The finish is long and fresh. From organically grown grapes. Drink now. 91 POINTS



CAMPO SAN GIORGIO 2013

This shows plenty of concentration on the nose with blackberry crumble and baking spices, but there's also a fine sense of licorice, mint, oyster shell and minerals. Full-bodied and nicely fresh on the palate. Layers of blue fruit and velvety tannins cascade through the medium-long finish. Drink in 2020.

CUMARO 2014

Shows dark plums and cherries. blackberry bush, dried herbs and balsamic vinegar. Medium to full body, some nicely chewy tannins and a bright finish. Drink now. 91 POINTS



SAN LORENZO 2016

Lots of licorice and elderberry on the nose, announcing a red that lies far from modern wine trends with fresh tannins lifting the medium-full body. A clove note at the vivid finish. Drink now.
