87 Umani Ronchi Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Jorio 2014 \$19 This light- to medium-bodied red is balanced and accessible, offering lively black cherry and mulberry fruit, with hints of smoke, mocha and dried thyme. Light tannins show on the modest finish. Drink now. 10,000 cases made.—A.N.

87 Umani Ronchi Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Podere 2015 \$13 This is light-bodied and bright, with an easy-drinking mix of blackberry, licorice snap, orange zest and smoke, followed by a subtle, lightly herbed finish. Drink now. 40,000 cases made.—A.N.

86 Umani Ronchi Pecorino Terre di Chieti Vellodoro 2015 \$16 A crisp and light-bodied white, with citrusy acidity enlivening the hints of nectarine, blanched almond and star fruit. From Abruzzo. Drink now. 12,000 cases made.—A.N.
